

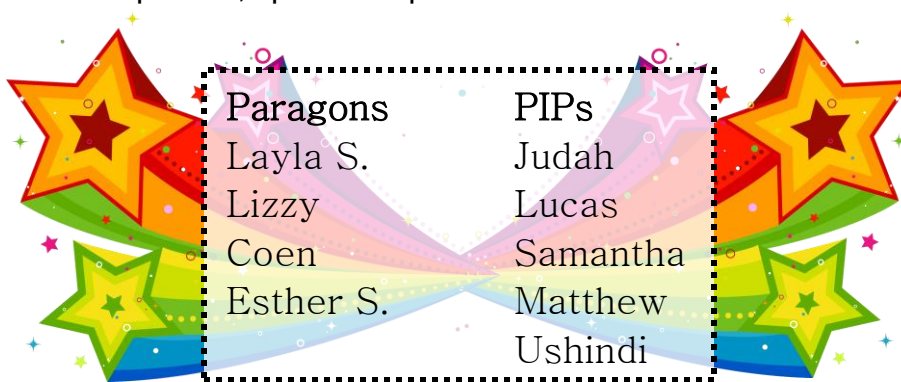

MAP Testing

February 6-10 will be testing week at Parkview for grades K-8. We utilize the **MAP Growth** assessment, a trusted tool for measuring growth and achievement.

Students will complete **Math, Reading and Science** tests. MAP reports allow teachers to gauge whether a student is at, below, or above grade-level in order to tailor instruction and set realistic goals for each student. Please be sure, as always, that your child is getting adequate rest and nutrition during this week to help them perform at their best.



Updated Attendance Policy

The school board noticed an inconsistency in our attendance policy and voted to clarify this standard in the handbook. We apologize that this was not included in the recent update to the handbook this past fall and we want our communication and expectations to be clear. The attendance policy now states that:

“A student shall be determined to have an unacceptable attendance record who accumulates **three unexcused absences** and/or **six unexcused tardies** for a grading period.”



This policy will go into effect next grading period (beginning January 23rd). Please refer to **pages 18-19** of the handbook to review circumstances for excusable absences or tardies as well as the repercussions for meeting or exceeding the limits of the attendance policy.

Pajama Day



This coming **Wednesday**, January 25 is **PAJAMA DAY!** Students may dress down in modest pajamas. If students are not participating by wearing pajamas, they must wear a regular school uniform.

After-School Clubs

Beginning **January 25**, any student who misses **more than 30 minutes of two club meetings** due to missing work will be **dismissed** from after-school clubs for the rest of the quarter. This policy change is made out of respect for our club volunteers who often show up and cannot start their club on time because students are in study hall working on missing assignments.

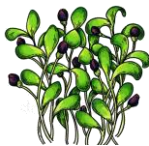

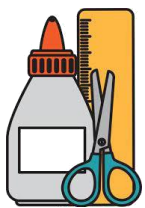
Alfalfa sprouts—\$4 / 4oz container

Volunteers Needed

Sicknesses

We kindly ask you to keep your child home if he/she is experiencing fever, chills, cough, difficulty breathing, body aches, sore throat, and/or loss of taste or smell. Children should remain home until they have received a **negative COVID test result and have been fever-free for 24 hours.** If coughing and/or sneezing persist, we ask that they wear a mask while at school.



Absent or Sick Child/Early Pick-Up

If your child will be absent for the day, please call the office **before 9am** to inform us of the reason for the absence. If you need to arrange an early pick-up, please call the office no later than the morning of to notify of **medical appointments** and at least an hour in advance (if able) in the event of an **emergency.**



After-School Care/Late Pick-Up

Program hours: **M-Th 3:15-5:30pm** and **F noon-3:00pm.**

Fee: **\$5/hour per child** and **\$1.25/quarter hour paid in advance, CASH only. No exceptions.**

An initial deposit of **\$60/child** must be paid the Friday prior to a student beginning after care. Any unused funds will roll over. **Each Friday you must bank up to \$60/child to allow him/her to participate in after care services the following week. Accounts which are not paid in advance AND dip into the negative and accrue new charges will be billed at the late pick-up fee of \$1/minute.**



Parents who have not picked up their child(ren) by **3:20pm M-Th** or **12:05pm on Friday** will accrue late pick up fees at the rate of **\$1/min,** added to your monthly statement.

If you are not able to pick your child up promptly at dismissal times, we encourage you to utilize this service. By paying in advance, the fee is \$5/hr. If you are late, but haven't paid in advance the fee is \$1 PER MINUTE which adds up quickly.
