# **Snow Days**

Mrs. Kaiser wishes to make the following announcement regarding school closures/delays due to inclement weather. We hope this information does not apply to us again for this school year, but it may smooth out communication in the future.

When inclement weather is expected, our staff regularly checks news reports to stay informed of the forecast, road conditions, and other school closures. We will always communicate our plan by posting our school by name on CNY Central and Channel 9 news (announced on air and posted on their websites) if there is a closure or delay. Sometimes area school districts are not in agreement. For example, Liverpool may only delay though Syracuse City closes. Please ALWAYS look for "Parkview Junior Academy" to be listed. We try very hard to announce changes no later than 6 am.

We also utilize the Jupiter portal to send blast communication to our families. It was previously communicated that failure to monitor your Jupiter account is not an option. We **must** know that we have a trusted way to relay information (especially when it's timesensitive or critical) to you.

Getting announcements out by these means takes a bit of focus and effort. Please text only after checking the sites listed and only if absolutely necessary.

In the event of a school delay, breakfast will not be served at school.

#### Sicknesses

# After-School Care/Late Pick-Up

**Hours:** M-Th 3:15-5:30pm, F noon-3:00pm.

**Fee:** \$5/hour per child (\$1.25/quarter hour) paid in advance, CASH only. No exceptions.

An initial deposit of \$60/child must be paid the Friday prior to a student beginning after care. Any unused funds will roll over. Each Friday you must bank up to \$60/child to allow him/her to participate in after care services the following week. Accounts which are not paid in advance AND dip into the negative and accrue new charges will be billed at the late pick-up fee of \$1/minute.



Parents who have not picked up their child(ren) by **3:20pm M-Th** or **12:05pm on Friday** will accrue late pick up fees at the rate of **\$1/min**, added to your monthly statement.

If you are not able to pick your child up promptly at dismissal times, we encourage you to utilize this service. By paying in advance, the fee is \$5/hr. If you are late, but haven't paid in advance the fee is \$1 PER MINUTE which adds up quickly.
